As Mr. Crockett has now authorised us to accept the revised terms upon which you are to publish his "Grey Galloway" and I have written (on the 20th) to Dr. Nicoll to that effect, I take pleasure in sending you herewith complete 'copy' of the book together with the case containing the originals of Mr Pennell's illustrations.

You will remember that Messrs. Dodd, Mead and Co. have agreed to purchase the use of the Pennell illustrations and I shall be glad if you will kindly communicate with them and ascertain whether they wish you to send them the originals after you have made use of them so that they may make fresh blocks, or whether they will purchase blocks from you, paying for them of course a sum in addition to the £100 which they have agreed with us to pay for the use of Mr Pennell's drawings in the American edition of the books.
