Dear Mr. Lock,

Referring to our recent conversation I take this opportunity of putting formally on record that you are willing that we should permit the purchaser of the American serial rights of the above mentioned novel by Mr. Crockett to publish it serially in America either simultaneously with your issue of it in this country in "The Windsor" or on such other dates and at such other periods as may best suit his convenience, always provided that he issues the story in a periodical or periodicals which are not published in this country and that his serial publication does not in any case commence prior to the issue of the number of "The Windsor Magazine" containing the first instalment?
