Dear Unwin,

I had no idea I had been keeping proof - generally I managed to correct the first proof in a day or two - but the second proof which is being read by one or two specialists - takes a day or two longer. But I hope you will not have to keep back publication by a single day, for this reason among others because I have arranged my affairs to let me get to London in the third and fourth weeks of March when the reviews are beginning to appear, so that I should not like it to be later than the sixth or seventh of that month at the latest. I shall, as you say, send all the proof I have (revise) this week. I have already sent the first (galley) proof, and send today all to 192 by this post. Some more is nearly done, and shall follow later. I have received this morning 305 -336 so that there is from 193-336 in my hands which shall come quickly, and if the rest of the revies comes on at once, I shall return well within the week.
