Dear Sirs,

Referring to your letter to Mr. Joyce of the 3rd inst I write to say that we should be prepared to offer you the sum of £500 (five hundred pounds) for Mr. Crockett's story in place of £600, as you propose, subject to your having been able to report that you have made arrangements with Messrs. B.S. Lloyd & Co. for the publication of the story by them in Australasia.

We have an understanding with Messrs. Lloyd & Co. that they will purchase our Electrotypes, so that it would be only be necessary for you to arrange in this case for the publication of the story.

This offer is also made on the understanding that we are to illustrate the story and to send the Electrotypes of the Illustrations to Messrs. Harper & Brothers. Further, that the Rights themselves to us cover the Provincial Rights of the United Kingdom, and that the 'copy' will be delivered not later than March 30, 1895.
